## Kindergarten Readiness

All children in Monterey County ages 0-5 have access to holistic, equitable, and responsive child development services and resources so they are well prepared for school.

2022-23 percent of students who are socially and emotionally ready for kindergarten.


# Goal 2

## Early Grade Reading

All Monterey County students in kindergarten through third grade will have access to equitable reading and writing learning opportunities resulting in more students reading and writing at grade level.


# Goal 3

## Middle School Math


# Goal 4

## High School Graduation


# Goal 5


# Goal 6


# Goal 7
