CalKIDS accounts continue to be claimed

Thanks to the work of Bright Futures steering partners, in just a few months, more than **1,000** Monterey County children and youth have claimed over **2.8** million dollars in **FREE** college accounts.

There are over \$30 million still available for families to claim. In the county, over 64,000 children are eligible for these FREE accounts. Each child may qualify for up to \$1,500 to start their college savings. "We are so thankful to our sponsors for helping us promote and create awareness on CalKIDS," said Tony Amezcua, director of Bright Futures.
